### LAURIER CODE OF CONDUCT: How we SOAR at school, at home and in our world!




The start of the new calendar year is a perfect opportunity to revisit the Laurier School Code of Conduct. At school, we will be having Primary and Intermediate gatherings in the gym during our first week back to revisit what it looks like to SOAR and use our WITS at school. To help support our teaching and to foster a greater understanding, thank you for asking and/or reviewing these concepts at home with your child.

### ARRIVING FOR SCHOOL ON-TIME: It matters!

A consistent morning routine helps children feel prepared and ready to learn, setting a positive tone for the entire day. When students arrive on time, they can participate in essential morning activities such as reviewing the “shape of the day” with their class. This daily overview helps children understand what to expect, reduces anxiety, and supports the development of executive functioning skills—such as planning, organization, and time management—that are critical for lifelong success.

Late arrivals can disrupt these routines and make it harder for students to settle in. By ensuring your child is at school before the bell, you are helping them start the day calmly and confidently.
