January Days with Changes to the Schedule

Monday, January 12th – AM Collaborative Day, late start for students (10:05am)

Monday, January 26th – Semester Turnaround Day, no scheduled classes

Tuesday, January 27th - Semester Turnaround Day, no scheduled classes

IMPORTANT INFO: upcoming Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10 & 12 Assessments for 2025-26

The first round of Numeracy/Literacy assessments at Killarney for the 2025-26 school year will occur between **January 19-23, 2026**.

GRADE 10 STUDENTS:

- Grade 10 students enrolled in Science 10 in Semester 1 will do the **Literacy 10 assessment on Thursday, January 22nd**.
- Grade 10 students enrolled in Foundations Math 10 or Workplace Math 10 in Semester 1 will do the **Numeracy 10 assessment on Friday, January 23rd**.
- Grade 10 students enrolled in these courses in Semester 2 will do their assessments in April 2026.

GRADE 12 STUDENTS:

- Grade 12 students must also do the Literacy 12 assessment. Those students with English Studies 12 in Semester 1 will do their **Literacy 12 assessment on Tuesday, January 20th**.
- Students with English Studies 12 and English First Peoples 12 in Semester 2 will write the Literacy 12 assessment in April.

*** Any student who is not enrolled in these courses at Killarney will have an opportunity to complete the Numeracy 10, Literacy 10 and Literacy 12 assessments in January, April and June 2026.

Information on how to prepare for the assessments will be posted on GRADE TEAMS with question examples and videos.

MyEducation BC will be open from **Monday, January 12 to Friday, February 20th** for students to input their course requests. Please be reminded that these are requests. We hope to be able to fulfill all students requests but there may be some times this may not be possible. For instance, courses may not run if there is not enough sign up for that particular class. It is important to make thoughtful choices about courses for next year because the timetable is built to meet these requests. Changes after February 20th may not be possible.



To input course students will need access to [MyEducation BC](#). It would be very helpful if you could sign in with your child to make sure they have access. If they do not have access they can email killarney@vsb.bc.ca from their school email account and a reset link will be sent to their email.

If you plan on taking a Completion course or Online course this summer:

- Do not sign up for the same course at Killarney that you intend to complete in summer or online.
- Sign up for the next level of your summer course at Killarney (Example: if you take Chemistry 11 in summer, sign up for Chemistry 12 at Killarney)
- If you do not complete the summer school course as planned and wish to do take the course in September at Killarney, you may not get a seat in the course if it is full. (Committing to your plan is important!)
- Summer school schedules come out in April and the registration date will be posted when the schedule is released (usually end of April/early May)

1. Book an appointment at [KILN](https://www.kiln.ca). There is no cost to book an appointment, but we do require a credit or debit card to secure the booking. Students are not charged until the time of their session.
2. Get photographed and pay the \$60 deposit. At the time of their session, students pay a \$60 deposit they can use toward a purchase later. We take both casual and formal photos, including one for the yearbook. If students choose not to order, we'll refund the deposit within 30 days.
