




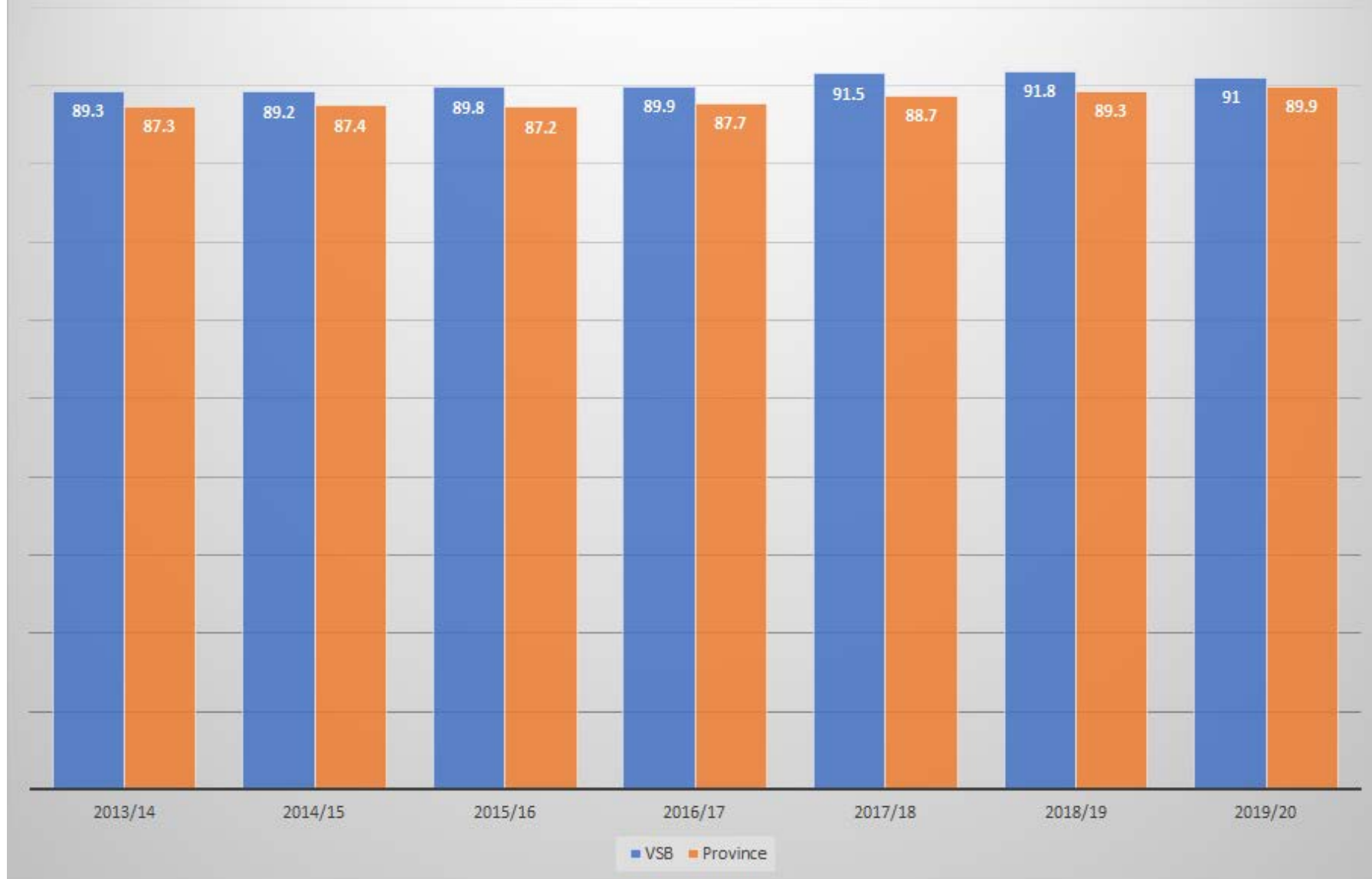

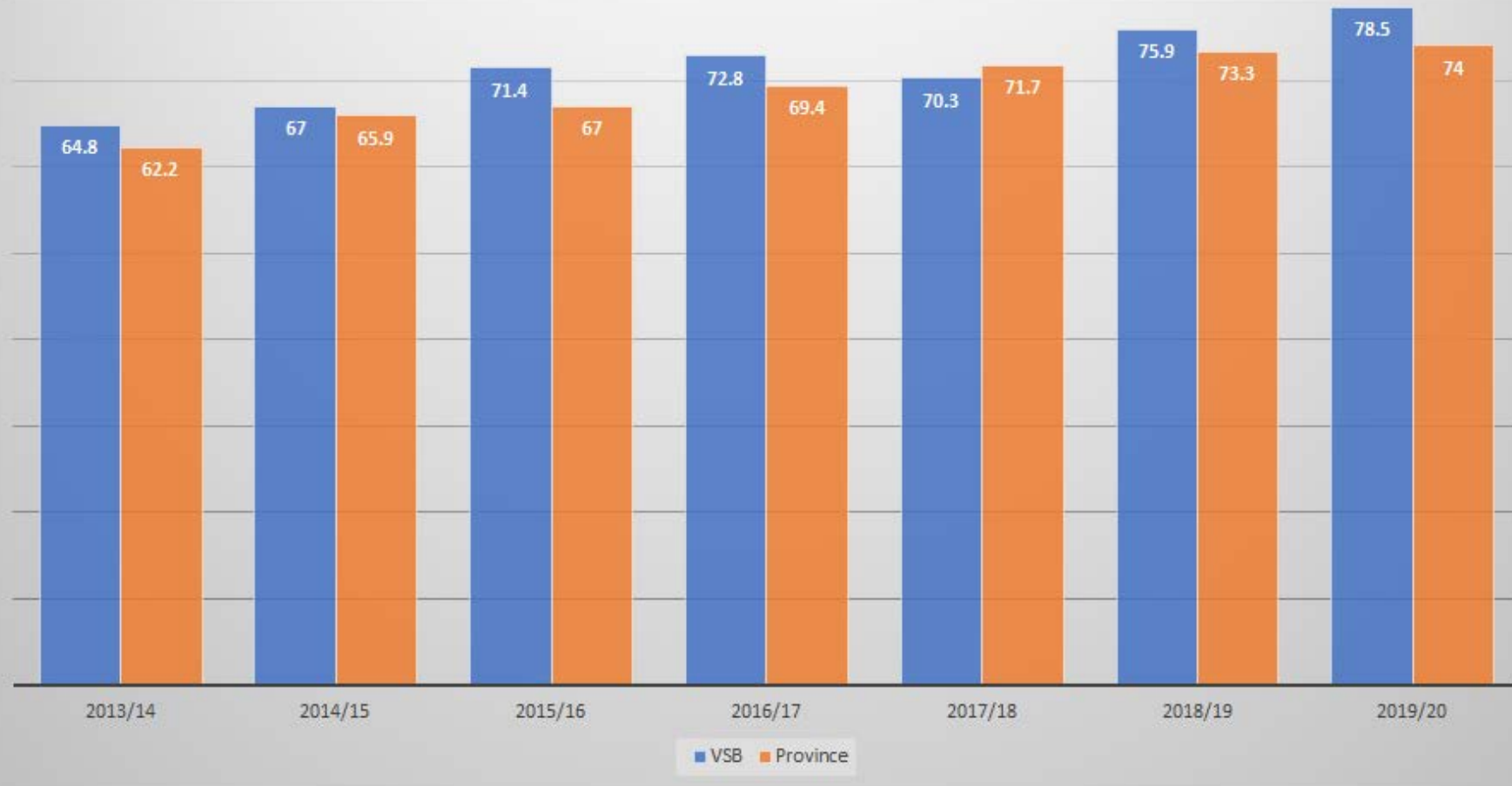
Student Achievement 2020 Completion Rates



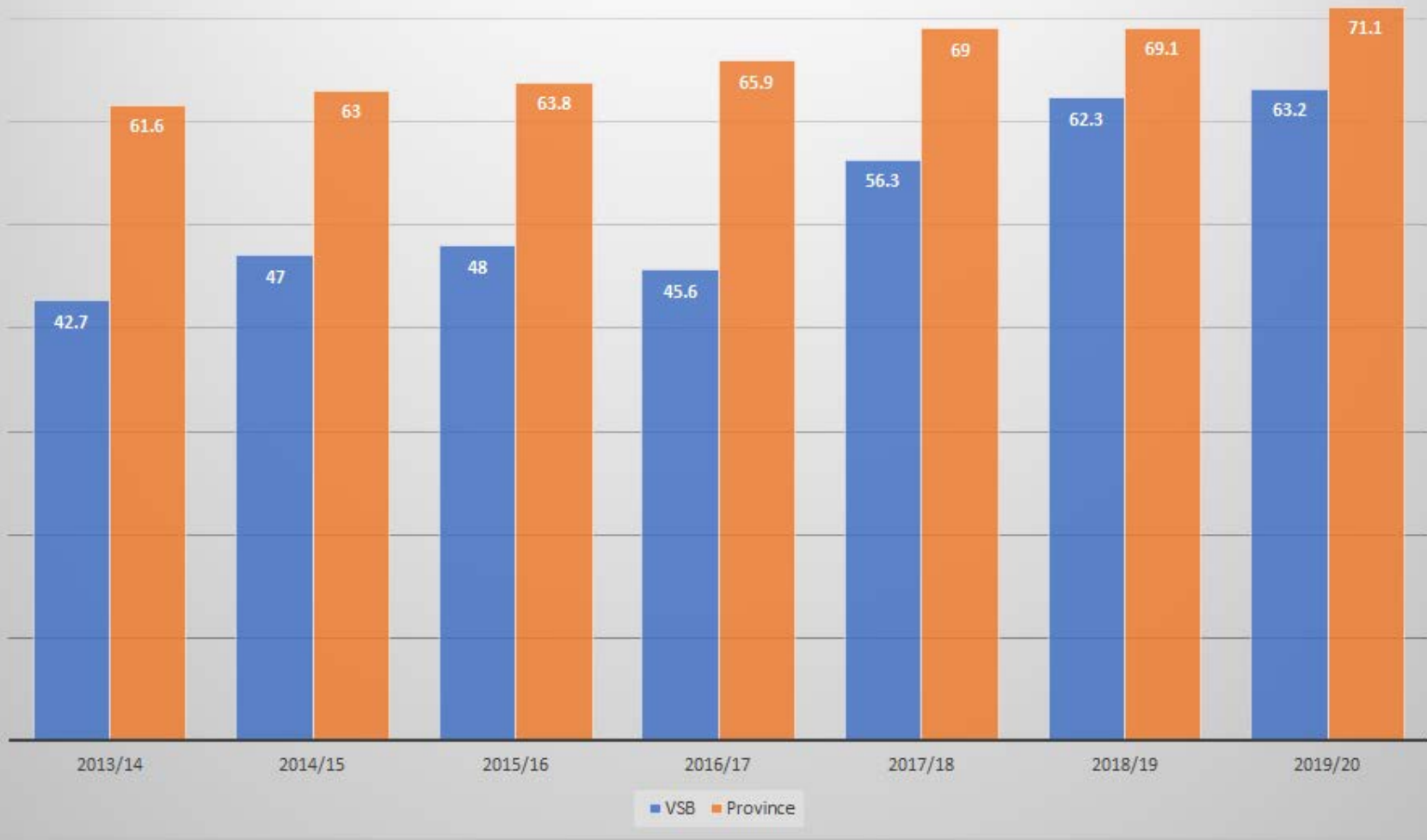
2020 Completion Rate

School and Worksite COVID Exposure Notifications

Months	Elementary Schools	Secondary Schools	Alt. Programs	Non-School Worksites

January 1 – 15, 2021	10	7	0	0

*There may be more than one exposure notification per school

Changes/Updates to PHO Guidance

Originally December 4th, 2020 – January 8th, 2021 now extended to February 5th, 2021

The [Use of Face Coverings in Indoor Public Spaces \(COVID\) Order](#) requires individuals 12 years of age and older to wear a mask or face covering in designated indoor public spaces

Exemptions to the provincial mask requirements apply to people who are unable to wear a mask

Changes/Updates to PHO Guidance

The [Provincial COVID Health and Safety Guidelines for K-12](#) (September 2020) require staff in all K-12 schools and students in middle/secondary schools to wear masks in high traffic areas or anytime outside of their learning group whenever physical distancing cannot be maintained

The Gathering and Events Order suspends all social events and gatherings

All non-essential travel should be avoided

District COVID Plan Updated January 2021

Significant Updates include:

Alignment with current PHO, MOE and BCCDC guidance, orders, or recommendations

COVID Symptoms and Recommended Actions

- New Daily Health Assessment template for K-12 from BCCDC and MOE expected in February

Clarification on self-monitoring, self-isolations and VCH processes

Gatherings for essential business purposes

- Limits and conditions

Curriculum specific updates

- Music, physical education, sports

COVID supplies and materials as of January 19th, 2021

Reusable non-medical face masks

- Order delivery expected February 2021
- 2 per person for all staff and students
- 3-ply

Hand sanitizer

- ~ 3000 L/month being used
- Supply chain of up to 30,000 L secured by the district
- Delivery as per monthly orders

Plexiglass available on the recommendation of the local Site Health and Safety Committee

- To date ~ 300 pieces issued

Face shields

- To date ~ 6,000 face shields distributed with more in stock
