Student Photo Orders due on September 26th



School Fees 2023-2024

Any families experiencing financial hardship may ask that these fees be waived by contacting the school Principal, Vital Peeters, (vpeeters@vsb.bc.ca). All requests will be treated confidentially.

The following two fees are posted:

School Cash Online



For parents new to the school, School Cash Online is an online parent portal that offers a safe, fast and convenient way to pay for school activity fees. The portal is customized to meet the school's needs and allows you as a parent to add your children, make payments, check current balance/account history, print or view receipts.

How to Register:

- 2. Confirm your Email: Check your inbox for the email confirmation and click on the link inside. Sign in with your new log-in details.
- 3. Add a student: Click "Add Student" and fill in the required fields with your child's details.




- 1. Personal Information Verification Form (Will be distributed to students individualized) Required

School Grounds and Student Pick up/Drop off




Please note that the front playground will be supervised from 8:40 to 9:00 am and from 3:03 to 3:18 pm. At the beginning of each day (9:00 am), classroom teachers will meet students at a designated spot and escort them into the school. At the end of the day (3:03 pm), students will return to the same spot for pick-up by parents. Students not picked up by 3:18 pm will be taken to the office and a parent contacted. Thank you for picking up your child promptly at dismissal.

We specifically ask that after pick up/drop off, parents remain off school grounds until 3:18 pm as this allows for easier identification of students who have not yet been picked up by a parent or guardian.



Terry Fox Run Results



Our school's annual Terry Fox Run was held on the afternoon of Friday, September 15th.

Together, JQ students and staff traveled approximately 1,033.8 kms, about a fifth of the 5,373 kms Terry Fox ran.

The school will continue to accept donations until Friday, October 27th. Donations can also be made online by clicking <u>HERE</u>. All donations are voluntary. Thank you.

























Distraction-free Learning



To help maintain a distraction-free, safe and caring learning environment, JQ families are asked not to send children to school with cell phones or other electronic devices.

During the school day, and any time students are in the care of school staff, including field trips and before and after school extracurricular activities, communication between students and families must go through the office or the staff member in charge.

Any electronic device used by students during the school day, including before and after school, recess and lunch, and during field trips and extracurricular activities may only be with teacher or staff permission and direct supervision.

Families that choose to send children to school with a cell phone or other electronic device in case of emergencies during the trip to and from school must ensure their child understands the phone or device may only be used at school with teacher or staff permission and direct supervision. Any personal electronic devices students bring to school must be turned off or put on silent mode and stored in their school bag for the duration of the school day, including before and after school, and during any school sponsored activities.

Students unable to abide by the policy described above will have the phone or device confiscated and turned in to the office. A parent or guardian will be asked to come retrieve the phone or device and be reminded of the policy.

Allergy aware school





We ask that families avoid including foods that contain potentially life-threatening allergens such as nuts and nut products in lunches or snacks.

All VSB schools are also Air Aware, meaning students, staff and visitors are encouraged to use fragrance free and unscented shampoos, hairsprays, deodorants, lotions, and other products, and avoiding application of perfume and cologne.

Parents may come to the school office to collect and sign-out their child.
