



Safe Arrival and Reporting Student Absences



To report your child's absence, please call **604-713-5159**, **Ext. 39**, prior to 9:00 am on the first day of the absence. If your child arrives late to school, they should report to the office and sign-in.

2024-2025 School Organization

Changes to JQ's enrolment and staffing have necessitated changes to the organization planned in the spring. Students will move into their new divisions the afternoon of Monday September 9.

Monday morning, please continue to drop off your child in the same meeting place as this week with last year's teacher. Monday afternoon, students will be dismissed from a new location by their new teacher. If you're not sure where to find your child after school, look for primary (grades 1-3) students on the west (Crown Street) side of the school, and look for intermediate (grades 4-7) students in the lane between the school and the pool. After 3:13 PM, students who haven't been picked up will be instructed to go to the office so their families can be contacted.

Please also expect an introductory email from your child's new teacher with more information.

School Grounds and Student Pick up/Drop off



Please note that the front playground will be supervised from 8:40 to 8:55 am and from 2:58 to 3:13 pm. At the beginning of each day (9:00 am), classroom teachers will meet students at a designated spot and escort them into the school. At the end of the day (2:58 pm), students will return to the same spot for pick-up by parents. Students not picked up by 3:13 pm will be taken to the office and a parent contacted. Thank you for picking up your child promptly at dismissal.



Student Photo Day - Tuesday, Sept 10



All students will have an individual photo taken on **Tuesday, September 10th** beginning with primary grades in the morning and intermediate grades, late morning to early afternoon. Edge Photography is our school photographer. Parents will be able to see and purchase their child's photo with Edge in due course.

A photo retake morning is scheduled for **Wednesday, October 23rd** and any students not in attendance on Tuesday can have their photo taken on the retake date.

Punctuality

It is important to be on time.

Being on time prevents disruption to your child's learning and that of others. Some activities start promptly at 9:00 am. In addition, it shows respect for your child's teacher and other educators.

A welcome bell rings at 8:55 am and this is the time for students to line up and be met by the teacher. The beginning of learning day bell rings at 9:00 am and hopefully all students are present and ready to head to the classroom.

Dismissal this year is at 2:58 pm. We also request that students be picked up on time, this is especially important for younger children who may become upset when a parent is late.

Personal Digital Devices during school hours



As you may know, in January 2024, the Province of B.C. mandated all school boards to update their Codes of Conduct to limit students' use of personal digital devices during school hours.

Elementary

Personal digital devices are now restricted throughout the instructional day (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). This includes class time, recess and lunch. Devices must be turned off or set to silent mode and kept out of sight for the entire school day.

Schools may provide additional information or guidelines to support the updated Code of Conduct⁵ (section 1.3.5). We kindly ask everyone to join us in encouraging students to develop digital literacy skills and use technology solely for educational purposes while at school.

Allergy Aware

The Vancouver School District and École Jules Quesnel are committed to providing as safe a learning and teaching environment as is practicable for anaphylactic students. In addition to the precautions taken by school staff and the families of allergic children, all JQ families are asked to be 'allergy-aware' and to consider the following strategies to minimize the risk of exposure for allergic children.

- Try to avoid sending your child to school with allergenic foods.
- Encourage your child to wash their hands regularly, especially before and after eating.
- Discourage sharing of food at school.

All VSB schools are also 'air aware', meaning students, staff and visitors are encouraged to use fragrance free and unscented shampoos, hairsprays, deodorants, lotions, and other products, and avoiding application of perfume and cologne.

Active travel to and from school



Students, families and staff are encouraged to consider active modes of transportation for getting to and from school. There is only limited parking around JQ. Please refer to the image below for information regarding parking and traffic flow around JQ.
