The journey towards the playoffs was a rollercoaster of emotions but they kept resilient. During the season, many schools took note of their performance and they were invited to a record number of 5 tournaments. Overall, the team placed 4th in the district in some very tight games in the semis. Qualifying for tier 1 provincials they competed against the top high schools in at the BC Ultimate High School Championships in Surrey. Coming in ranked at the bottom of their pool they rallied and upset higher level teams to end with in 5th place. The Cougars dominated and earned our name as one of the top teams in the province. How can we have a track team with no track? Well, DT's Coach, Ian Coccimiglio stepped up and agreed to Coach DT's team and Killarney's at Memorial Track (just down the road).

We've had a great turnout and lots of eager new and experienced cougars. It was great to see so many students come out that have never been on the team before. The senior more experienced teammates have stepped up to help lan train DT & Killarney athletes in racewalk, hurdles, steeplechase, sprints, relays, and for field: javelin, shotput, triple jump & long jump, just to name a few of the popular events. We would really like to see more grade 8's and 9's come out next year!

We've had some great results so far and multiple PB's! We had 41 Killarney Cougars compete at Zones, and around 21 will be going to Provincials next week in Langley. Our Jacob Amos broke a Zone record, and now holds the fastest time (1:59.71) for Sr Boys in the 800m event! Also during the Zones Championships, Killarney Secondary came in 2nd place for most accumulative points overall! (Kitsilano came first, but they had double the amount of athletes.)
