#### **September 2021 Information**

Attached again is the 2021-2022 Tennyson Calendar which shows all of our Professional Development Days, Early Dismissals, and Instructional Days. We previously sent the 2021-2022 School Fee letter. You will receive a package in September with instructions about payment. We share the fee information with parents now to give you advance notice (these were also contained in a previous email to all families, and are on our school website in the *Publications* section).
