





#### LORD BYNG ENGLISH COURSES (Revised Feb. 2024)

#### **English Course Options to Fulfill REQUIREMENTS** BLUE boxes are course for students in the Main School. English 8 OR English 8 YELLOW boxes are courses for students in Byng Arts. (Byng Arts) GREEN boxes are courses open to all students, in both the Main School and Byng Arts. English 9 ORANGE font courses are in the English First Peoples stream. English 9 OR (Byng Arts) Any one of these courses will fulfill the Indigenous-focused graduation requirement. **English First Peoples** English 10: 10: Lit Studies & OR Lit Studies & Composition **English First Peoples** Literary Studies 11 11: Lit Studies & OR Literary Studies 11 (AP Preparation) Spoken Language **English Studies 12 English First Peoples** OR **English Studies 12** OR (AP Preparation)

#### **Senior English ELECTIVES**

- Open to ALL students in Grades 11 & 12, both Main School and Byng Arts.
- Teacher permission is NOT required.
- CANNOT be used to replace a Grade 11 or Grade 12 Language Arts graduation requirement (e.g., English Studies 12).
- Literary Studies 12 (British Literature) counts as an approved academic course for university admission.
- Creative Writing 12 is accepted by some universities as an academic course.
- If these courses are oversubscribed, priority goes to Grade 12s. Students in the Main School and in Byng Arts will have equity of access.







# HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD CHOOSE THEIR COURSES

- Be aware of your own mindset and experiences
- Secondary school is a time of discovery and exploration
- Consider what students are good at, like to learn about, and want to try (passionate, curious)
- Can think about post secondary options <u>but</u> keep in mind institutions and faculties have different admission requirements and that requirements can change, especially with the new curriculum changes
- University requirements are different from high school graduation requirements

## **BALANCE**



Balance is not something you find; it is something you you create.

Consider balance when thinking about course selection!

#### Dogwood Diploma - at a glance

The B.C. Certificate of Graduation or "Dogwood Diploma" is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements.

Students require a minimum of 80 credits to graduate.

#### Of these 80 credits:

- At least 16 credits must be at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12 and Career Life Connections
- At least 28 credits must be elective course credits
- Effective July 1, 2023: At least 4 credits must have an Indigenous-focus (see <u>Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirements - Province of British Columbia (qov.bc.ca)</u> for additional information)
- 52 credits are required from the following:
  - Career-Life Education (4 credits), and Career-Life Connections (4 credits)
  - Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits)
  - Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
  - Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
  - A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 or 12 (4 credits)
  - A Language Arts 10, 11 and a required 12 (12 credits total)
  - An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits total)

In addition, students must also complete three graduation assessments:

- The Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment was introduced in 2018
- The Grade 10 Literacy Assessment was introduced in 2019/20
- The Grade 12 Literacy Assessment will be introduced in 2021/22


