Dear Laurier Community,



Stage Coach Drama Workshops February 11- 13: Divisions 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 9

Acting, whether on-stage or on-screen, is an inherently collaborative art form. This makes it a perfect vehicle in which to explore the theme of Creating Connection to Yourself and Others. Humans are social creatures and learning how to make mindful connections enables us to connect with ourselves and others in the world around us.

Students will:

• Be present and aware of themselves and other performers, and respond in a supportive manner while working collaboratively.

• Reflect and describe their emotional experience of a theatrical activity as an observer and as a participant.

• Trust their emotional experience and actively participate by making and accepting offers while working in a group.

• Demonstrate a willingness to take risks by exploring and experimenting with various emotions and physicality within the exercises.

Van Go Visual Arts Outreach Program: A WORLD OF BIRDS February 24-26: Divisions 3, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11

Students will have the opportunity to create a unique, realistic drawing of a bird (within its own habitat) using the fundamental elements of art and design. To inspire these workshops, students will be introduced to the historical artist James Fenwick Landsdowne, who drew and painted birds his entire life, and contemporary artist Myfanwy MacLeod, whose monumental sculptures of chickadees are on permanent display in Vancouver's Olympic Village.

MORNING/AFTERNOON SUPERVISION

If your child will be absent from school, please call **604-713-5159** to report this absence as early as possible. Parents should leave a message at the dedicated answering service by calling the number provided. You will be prompted to provide the two-digit extension for your child's school to access the school's voicemail box for reporting an absence. The two-digit extension for Laurier Elementary is **44**.

It is important to report your child's absence prior to 9:00 a.m. each day of the absence.

If your child is late for school they must sign in at the office before they make their way to the classroom.

School offices are busy places: consistently notifying the school in advance of your child's absence will significantly improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Safe Arrival Morning Routine.
