For the last 5 years, Byng has repaired and maintained dozens of bikes, many of which are used in Physical Education Classes, and for class bike rides in Pacific Spirit Park. We have also donated many bikes to the non-profit organization, Our Community Bikes, which then donates them to people facing financial hardship.
