


Figure 2 One of the main highlights for the evening was the costume dance!!!

The Truth and Reconciliation journey continued this week with Martin Sparrow from the Musqueam Nation inviting classes to participate in a series of paddle teaching workshops. So far twelve classes have attended this introductory workshop with the second workshop in the series now planned that will involve Martin visiting classrooms to complete the carving and painting of the ceremonial paddles with the students and their teacher.

Another first step for our Reconciliation journey was held last week with students from the entire Vancouver School District through a Microsoft Teams broadcast. The broadcast was led

by the renowned Indigenous Artist Andy Everson from the Khomoks First Nation on Vancouver Island. During the presentation Andy shared his history, culture and background and spoke about the many traditions and teachings that had been forbidden and punished because of the Indian Act and the bans on the Potlatch ceremony and other cultural practices.

During the presentation Andy shared his life journey and explained how he became a renowned internationally recognized artist. He also went on to describe how he infused his traditional West Coast artistic heritage with contemporary Western images including the fusion of characters from the Star Wars series and images created to celebrate sporting accomplishments by the Vancouver Canucks.

FIT time is a period of instructional time built into the Lord Byng schedule that gives our students the opportunity to have choice in their learning time. Examples of some ways to use FIT time include:

- Meeting with teachers for support in subject learning or completing assignments
- Connecting with counsellors
- Individual study time
- Work Experience 11 and 12

- Attending tutorial sessions
- Collaborating with peers on projects
- Career Education lessons and meetings
- Enrichment passion projects

Ultimately, FIT time empowers our students to take ownership of their own learning and gives them the opportunity to develop core competencies such as personal responsibility, self-regulation, goal setting, wellbeing, and communication.


