STEAM Education

While Career Education students learned about potential opportunities for future employment, students in the Applied Skills area of learning used their knowledge to complete projects that required them to draw on all their areas of learning.

Frequently referred to as <u>STEM or STEAM</u> learning, the school continues to develop resources that will allow for the further development of STEAM & STEM learning.

Recent school improvements that support this type of learning include:

The replacement of shop tools includes the introduction of two Saw Stop table saws

- The replacement of lathes in the metal shop
- The upgrade of the multi-Purpose Room that is currently shared between the Applied Skills and Fine Arts Departments
- The replacement of computers in A006




Figure 7 Engineering students celebrate their accomplishments as they test out their newly constructed invention, a marble ride that includes a mouse trap to launch a marble onto an upper level for a second run down the slope.

Ultimately, FIT time empowers our students to take ownership of their own learning and gives them the opportunity to develop core competencies such as personal responsibility, self-regulation, goal setting, wellbeing, and communication.


