A Gift to the School

Special thanks this week go to a former student at Byng Secondary School for showing his gratitude to staff and the Byng students by donating a vast array of spare bike parts including frames, wheels, inner tubes and other supplies. All these parts and materials went to support the Byng Mechanics Club. The Bike Mechanics Club is run by Modern Languages, Career Education and Social Justice teacher Mr. Alain Raoul.

Mr. Raoul and his students were delighted to receive these resources as they are currently working with students, staff and the VSB Trades Department to organize the Bike Room on the ground floor of the building.

The Club recently received support from the Byng PAC to buy shelving and other storage units to allow bikes to be stored in the room without taking up floor space. Materials belonging to the Club had previously been stored in the Engineering Room adjacent to the Wood and Metal Shops. This multi-purpose space in the shop area is also shared by the Fine Arts Department who can now store the materials needed for the ceramics program in the room previously used by the Bike Mechanics Club.

Black Excellence Day

Another important date in our school calendar, Black Excellence Day, was recognized on Wednesday January 15th.

During the morning PA Mr. Johnston and his student team of broadcasters explained to the school the importance of the day, highlighting these important facts:

- Black Excellence Day was created by Ninandotoo Society and takes place on January 15th each year, or the
 preceding Friday if it falls on a weekend or holiday. In 2024, Black Excellence Day is on January 15th.
- January 15th is in honour of the great US civil rights leader, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. who was born on January 15, 1929.
- The contributions of Black Canadians and the ongoing civil rights struggle of Black Canadians often go unacknowledged in our history books and school curriculum.
- The term Black Excellence was born out of the civil rights movement in the 1960s.

- Career Education lessons and meetings
- Enrichment passion projects

Ultimately, FIT time empowers our students to take ownership of their own learning and gives them the opportunity to develop core competencies such as personal responsibility, self-regulation, goal setting, wellbeing, and communication.


