couple of year. There's lots of vegetables, sunflower seeds, peas of various sorts, radishes, arugula, marigold seeds and smaller quantities of other seeds, so come to the library and get some. The seeds are free to be used.

There are 4-5 sponsor teachers for different garden boxes this year, so we'll be sharing the workload more. Depending on what sorts of crops teachers choose to grow with their kids, we may need volunteer families to water over the summer for a week at a time. Let Ms. Koke know if you are interested in signing up for watering duties for a week and your availability and she'll make a schedule. When it's hot, the boxes need watering every 2-3 days.
