

Track and field athletes at all grade levels will have the chance to take part in mini-meets over the next couple of weeks. Students are highly encouraged to attend all mini-meets for their grade level.

Participants' families are responsible for transportation to and from mini-meets.

If you plan to drive children other than your own, **you must complete a driver permission form in person at the school office before the first minimeet.** Forms should be submitted at least two days in advance, as staff need to review your driver's license, car insurance, and obtain the principal's signature.



IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

Please ensure your child brings their lunch with them in the morning.

Lunches kept in a thermos will stay hot, and our <u>hot</u> <u>lunch program</u> is available on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. We kindly ask that you do not drop off or bring lunch to your child during the day.

Additionally, **please pick up your child <u>promptly</u> at 3:00 p.m.** Please call the office if you anticipate being 10-15 minutes late. Late pickups can cause your child to feel anxious.

- 2. Date your child will be absent **OR** if arriving late, time of return.

When students are picked up early - They must **SIGN OUT** at the Office **BEFORE** pick up.



Pre-sale packages **must be ordered by May 20th** and will not be available on the day of the fair.


