SALMONIDS IN THE CLASSROOM Once again this year, Grenfell was part of the Salmonids in the Classroom program. Beginning in January, Grenfell received 57 Coho Salmon eyed eggs. Students were able to watch the salmon grow from eggs to alevin and then into fry. They learned about the life cycle of salmon

and their place in the ecosystem. As part of the program, Div. 9 and Div. 12 watched a salmon dissection demonstrated by Ms. Lee. Dissecting salmon provided an invaluable learning experience of learning about the different parts of a salmon. When the salmon fry were big enough, Div. 9 and Div. 12 took a fieldtrip to Renfrew Ravine to release them into the
