Digital books, read aloud & read along books

The Vancouver School District offers a selection of eBooks which are available all year long including summer holidays. here

Students/parents can go to https://library.vsb.bc.ca/ 1 > Log In

Username is the student's 7-digit student number (Only the digits DO NOT include @learn.vsb.bc.ca). Password is the same password they use for Teams/Office365 etc, if they've established a password.

2 ways to search for eBooks:

- 1) When searching for eBooks, filter your search by changing "Material Type" to "Electronic Book (eBook)" and look for books with this symbol.
- 2) Another way to search for eBooks, is to skip #1, and instead select "Destiny Discover" from the side bar, which will allow you to scroll down and browse available eBooks in a more visual format.
