Class Placement



In designing our new classes for September, the staff works together to build classroom communities that reflect all that we have learned about your child. The guiding principle is to create classroom communities that will enhance the learning of each child within the larger context of the needs of all children.

This is not an easy task. MacCorkindale staff invests a great deal of time and thought into this process.

Placement in a combined class does not reflect in any way your child's academic ability. Placement in a combination class at the lower grade does not mean that your child will cover the curriculum of the upper grade or receive an advanced program. The same holds true for a student who is in the upper end of a split class - your child does not receive a non-advanced program because students from a lower grade are in the same classroom; nor will your child be academically penalized by being placed into the combination class, rather than a straight class.

Our teachers do an excellent job of placing all of the students.

School Office Summer Closure

The office is closed for the summer from Tuesday, July 2nd to Friday, August 23rd. The school will re-open on Monday, August 26th.

Report Cards

The June Summary of Learning will go home on Monday, June 24th. If your family will be leaving school early, we will hold the report card at the office, and it can be picked up in September.



Notice of Late Return

All students are expected to attend school on the first day of the new school year which is <u>Tuesday</u>. <u>September 3rd</u>. If your child(ren) will be returning to school late in September, it is <u>ESSENTIAL</u> that the parent or legal guardian notify the school by filling out the <u>Notice of Late Return Form</u> or present a note in writing by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>June 27th</u>, <u>2024</u>, so that the student will remain enrolled in the school. Space <u>will not</u> be held beyond September 30th. The Late Return Form can be picked up in the office.

School Fees

School fees for 2024/25 is posted at the end of this newsletter. You will receive notification of the common school wide fees due via School Cash Online in the Fall. As per MacCorkindale's past practice, fees for programs, workbooks and fieldtrips for students will be collected as needed. They are specific to your child(ren)'s class. For the 2024/25 school year, the PAC have generously covered the cost of student agendas. Thank you, PAC!

First day of school is Tuesday, September 3

The first day of instruction for the 2024-2025 School Year will be Tuesday, September 3rd. Students will be attending from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. This is an important day to "check-in" and let us know you are attending MacCorkindale. Students who do not come on this day must contact the school immediately to let us know their status. No space can be held, so it is very important that you connect with us if you will not be here on September 3rd.

Please note the following information:

- All returning students, please report to your last year's classroom (line-up in the same location as you did during the 2023-2024 school year).
- All NEW students in Grades 1-7, please line up by the Main Doors by the "New Student" sign.
- New Kindergarten students will receive their gradual entry schedule over the summer.

Regular session begins Wednesday, September 4th, 9:00 am to 2:58 pm. Remember to bring a healthy snack and lunch for the day, as well as a water bottle.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

School Year 2024-25 (Payable in September 2024) Standardized School Fee Schedule

Financial Hardship Policy

The Board of Education is committed to ensuring that no school-age student will be denied an opportunity to participate in a course, class or program because of an inability to pay fees. Parents and guardians unable to pay some or all school fees are invited to speak to their child's teacher, school counsellor, and/or the school Principal.

\$35.00 GENERAL SCHOOL FEE

The Vancouver School Board offers the service of purchasing basic school supplies in bulk at wholesale prices and passing the cost savings on to families. The School Supply Fee for 2024-2025 is \$35.00 per student*. This fee covers basic consumable school supplies used for students' personal use such as paper, writing tools, glue sticks, erasers, exercise books and art supplies. Supplies are provided for the full year.

SUPPLEMENTAL FEES

Student Agenda/Planner \$0 (Thank you PAC!)	Some students at MacCorkindale Elementary will be using an Agenda/Planner. School agendas/planners are a valuable tool for teaching children how to organize and plan for school. While students are not required to have an agenda/planner it is designed to assist students with the skills of organization and time management and is a very useful communication tool often used between teachers and families.
Performance Fee \$10	We are pleased to enrich your child's learning through a wide variety of performances this year. This supplementary fee supports the school in bringing in talented and professional theatrical and musical performers that align with a particular educational theme. Parent support has made these opportunities possible and we appreciate your continued contribution. Sometimes, the PAC covers the whole cost so we may not request this fee.
Activity Fee \$TBD	This year some classes will be booking workshops. Parent support for this activity was confirmed last school year and we appreciate your contribution towards this opportunity. These fees will be charged at the time the workshops occur.
Workbooks \$32	This year, students in some division will be using a mathematics practice and homework book. This material supplements the classroom math program. The workbook is available for purchase at the cost of \$32. Students are not obligated to purchase the workbook, and may opt to use their copy as a reference textbook instead, meaning the workbook will be returned at the end of the school year for another student to use in the future. Students opting to use the workbook as a textbook will be responsible for ensuring that it remains unmarked and in excellent condition in order to return the workbook at the end of the year and receive reimbursement.
Field Studies – To be determined throughout the school year at the classroom level	Throughout the school year your child's teacher may plan supplementary learning opportunities at locations outside of the school and request monies towards entrance fees, transportation or equipment rental. Your child's teacher will communicate this information to you directly.
