Soft Plastics Collection

MacCorkindale is participating in a new pilot project that will collect flexible plastics, with the goals of:

- Increasing knowledge and understanding about the recycling of flexible plastics (aka soft plastic)
- Collecting flexible plastic at schools
- Encouraging the ongoing collection and recycling of this material at home once the pilot program is complete



We will be collecting residential flexible plastic like the kind often found in student lunches. For example, zipper-lock bags and stand-up pouches, crinkly granola bar wrappers, chip bags, and plastic grocery-type bags. This program will also accept flexible plastics collected from home such as bread bags, flexible packaging, plastic wrap, and woven plastic bags. Each participating school will receive an honorarium and Recycle BC will pay \$2.00 per kilogram of flexible plastic collected! Collection will happen for the entire month of May!

Think Of Me Initiative

Teaming up with the CREST (Community Road Education Safety Team) and ICBC, students crafted Think Of Me cards. These cards serve as reminders for motorists to prioritize safe driving, particularly in school zones. This morning, the CREST team was on 45th Avenue and Battison Street, distributing these thoughtful cards to the public.
