Your Kindergarten child may attend choir if your child can:

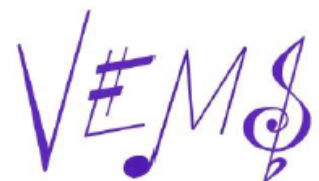
- Find and use the school bathroom on their own.

At every rehearsal there is a professional pianist to encourage tuning and experience live music making. Regular attendance is strongly recommended as new songs are regularly introduced.

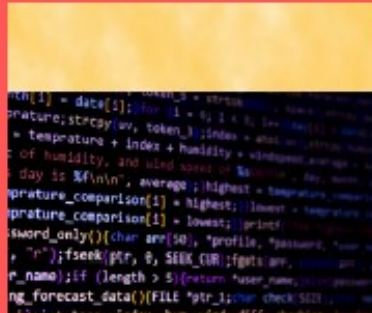

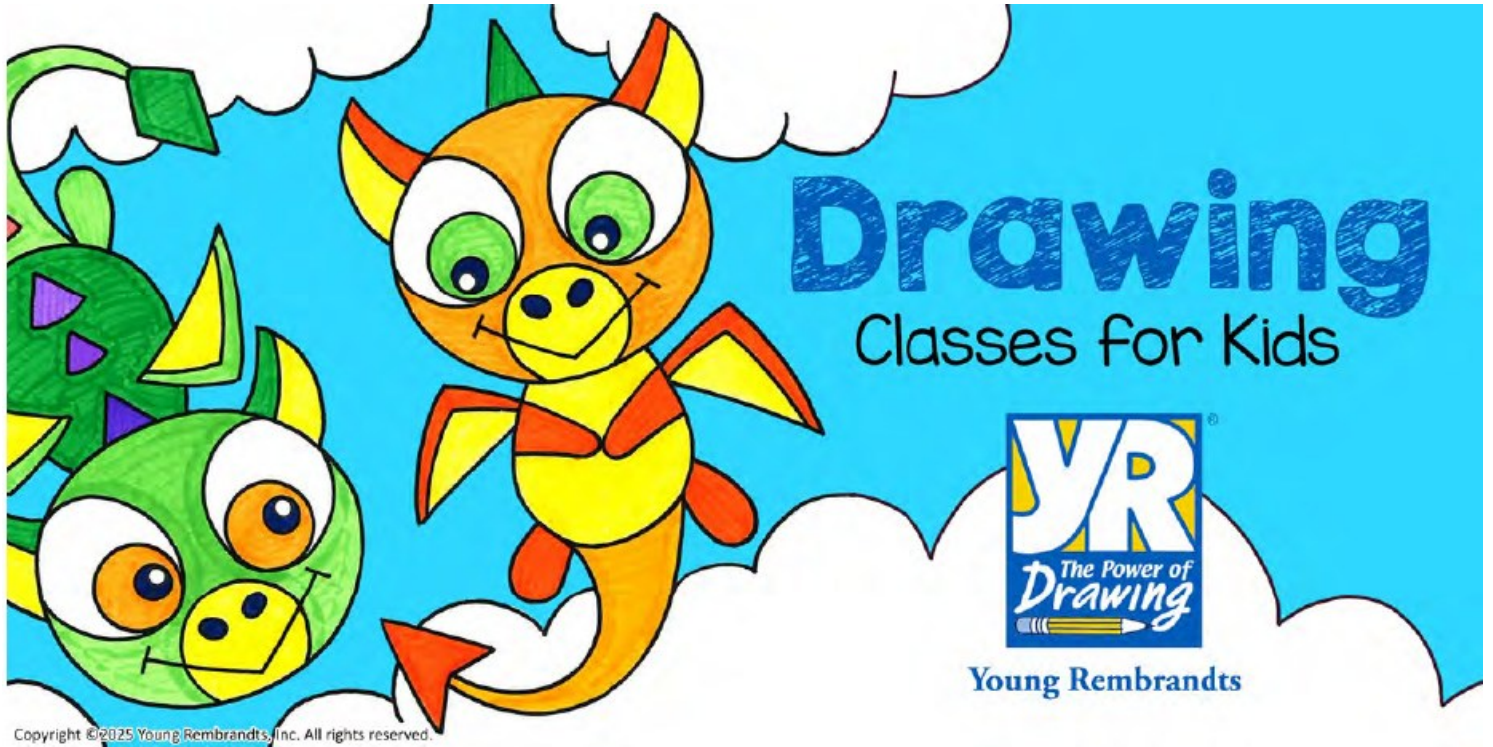
