Cool down and support our seniors! The Grade 7 class is hosting a **Popsicle Sale** to raise funds for their Year End activities.

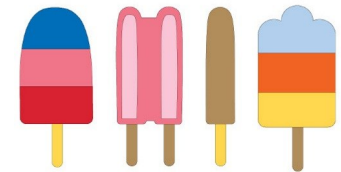

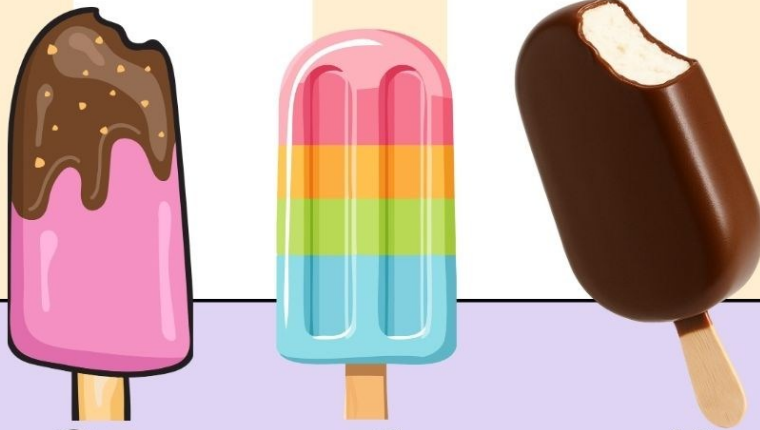
