Safe, late arrival and leaving early

If your child is going to be away or is sick, please leave a message at 604-713-4585 at anytime.

If arriving late, please have your child come to the office in order to sign in. If you need to pick up your child early during the day, please let your classroom teacher know in advance and please come to the office upon arrival to sign your child out.

Communication with Teachers

Email is one form of communicating with teachers but please remember that email is appropriate for general communication and that teachers are not able to discuss student behavior or progress via email. Issues requiring discussion are to be addressed through an appointment.

Also, it is always best to schedule an appointment in advance with your classroom teacher, by either contacting the office or sending your classroom teacher an email.

Concerns must be discussed with the teacher before contacting administration.

Playground Supervision

There are two staff members on supervision duty before school from **8:45 am until 9:00 am** and two staff members on duty after school from **3:03 pm to 3:15 pm**.

Recess

Welcome back to our hard working Supervision Aides Jennifer and Ivy. Congratulations to our third Supervision Aide, Anjli, who retired over the summer. Anjli's position will be posted and filled as soon as possible. Our three Supervision Aides are on duty outside at recess and lunch and therefore are at L'Ecole Bilingue from 10:30 am to 1:00 pm every day. Our Supervision Aides are very visible, as they wear the bright VSB orange and yellow vests when on the playground. Administration also helps with recess and lunch hour supervision.

The Primary students' designated play area is at the back of the school, while the Intermediate students play at the front of the school and on the gravel field.

As students are expected to play outdoors every recess and lunch recess, please have them come dressed for the weather.

Medication

If ever your child is prescribed a medication that needs to be administered during the school day, this includes a puffer or Epi Pen, Mme Christine, our first aid attendant, would be the person responsible for administrating the medication. We are only able to do so if we receive the signed VSB form from your physician. Please call the office if you need a form and we will send it home with your child. This protocol is put in place by the VSB for your child's protection.

Parking

Parking is extremely limited around the school. Please respect the parking signs accordingly and drive safely.

Please note that the staff parking lot is **not** to be used during school hours. Drop off or pick up your child in the staff parking lot is also not permitted.
