Emergency Preparedness

VSB continually strives to make schools safer for student through safety procedures and this includes the fire and earthquake drills practiced by all schools. We host 6 fire drills throughout the year to ensure that our students know what to do. We also conduct 2 lockdown drills per year and 2 earthquake drills. At our **BC Shake Out**, we conducted our earthquake drill with reunification which involved the school in releasing some students to



their parents. Drills help us to reflect and fine tune the details for succeeding drills. On May 2nd at 2:00pm, we will be participating in the district wide Earthquake Drill. McKechnie will also be inviting families to participate in the reunification portion of the drill. Student will practice "Duck, Cover and Hold-on" in their classrooms before evacuation.


