# MIDDLE YEARS DEVELOPMENT INSTRUMENT (MDI)

This year all Grade 6 students are invited to participate in the MDI survey. This survey is sponsored by the UBC Human Early Learning Partnership (HELP). The MDI is a self-report

questionnaire for students in BC. The questionnaire asks about how students think and feel about their experiences both inside and outside of school. The questionnaire is completed online through the e-MDI and takes 45 to 60 minutes to administer. The MDI questions align with the BC Ministry of Education's K-12 curriculum which includes a focus on promoting children's personal and social competencies.
