KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR 2019-2020



Applications for Kindergarten for the 2019–2020 year will begin on November 1st. Catchment students applying for registration between November 1st, through January 31st will be given first consideration over those who apply later. French Immersion Kindergarten will be determined by a District run lottery. If you have a child born in 2012 or know someone that will have a child attending Kindergarten in September 2019 please register them during the above time frame in order to help guarantee your child's placement in their home school.

SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

Students are supervised before school from 8:40am to 9:00am and after school from 3:00pm to 3:20pm. Children should not arrive before 8:40am or leave after 3:20pm unless specifically requested to do so as part of an organized/supervised activity, otherwise they will be unsupervised.




Division 3 wrote some lovely poetry:

FLU SEASON IS HERE!

What is the Flu?

Influenza (the flu) is a very contagious respiratory disease caused by a virus. It is passed from person to person by sneezing and coughing. Most healthy people who get the flu recover within two weeks. The flu can be a serious illness for infants, older adults and people with chronic diseases.

How can I prevent the flu?

• Get plenty of rest

- Get a flu shot every year • Eat a healthy diet
- ♦ Exercise regularly
- Stop smoking
- Wash your hands often

HAND WASHING

Why is hand washing important?

Research confirms that hand washing is the most important thing you can do to stop the spread of germs and reduce colds and flus.

How should I wash my hands?

- Wet your hands
- Apply plain soap (not antibacterial soap)
- Rub your hands together for at least 20 seconds or the time it takes to sing the alphabet
- Make sure to wash between your fingers and under your fingernails
- Rinse your hands to get all the germs and soap off
- Dry hands with a clean towel
- In public washrooms, turn off the water using a paper towel instead of bare hands
