Flexible Instruction Time (FIT)

We are currently looking at a model and software used in other VSB schools that will allow student to self-select where they will choose to be during FIT time. This would mean a change from the current model that has students stay with their class and would allow the students to realize the idea of choosing and self-regulating "where, when, and how their learning takes place."

FIT time occurs 4 x per week. On Mondays and Fridays the day begins with FIT that runs from 8:40-9:20 am.

Collaborative time occurs once/month and classes begin at 10:00 am on these days. The next one is Monday, Oct 16.

Be Early and On Time. Being 10 minutes early allows a student to get prepared and ready to start their day in a calm manner. This is a great habit for success. Being late disadvantages the individual and disrupts the learning environment of the entire class.

Student Illness

As we head into cold, flu, and now Covid season, it is important to have your child remain at home if they are ill. Work with your child to get a friend or two in each class that can update them on the work they have missed. You can also contact the teacher for longer absences.

<u>Masks</u>
