## Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10/12 Assessments 2024-25

The first round of Numeracy/Literacy assessments started this week. Grade 10 students enrolled in Physical Health and Education 10 in the first semester will do the Numeracy assessment on October 30 and the Literacy assessment October 31. Students with Physical Health and Education 10 in semester 2 will do their assessments in April. Grade 12 students also have to do the Literacy 12 assessment. Those students with English Studies 12 in the first semester will do their Literacy 12 assessment on November 5th. Students with English Studies 12 and English First Peoples 12 in semester 2 will write the Literacy assessment in April. Finally, any student who is not enrolled in Physical Health and Education 10,



English Studies 12, or English First Peoples 12 at Killarney will have an opportunity to complete the Numeracy 10, Literacy 10 and Literacy 12 assessments in April and June 2025.

Information on how to prepare for the assessments will be posted on GRADE TEAMS with question examples and videos.

## **Grad Photos**

Grade 12's can book an appointment for grad photos at Artona Studios. The photo sessions for Killarney grads will be taking place from November 13 to 18, 2024.

#### **How Artona Grad Sessions Work**

- 1. Book an appointment at <a href="www.artona.com">www.artona.com</a>. There is no cost to book an appointment, but we do require a credit or debit card to secure the booking. Students are not charged until the time of their session.
- 2. Get photographed and pay the \$60 deposit. At the time of their session, students pay a \$60 deposit they can use toward a purchase later. We take both casual and formal photos, including one for the yearbook. If students choose not to order, we'll refund the deposit within 30 days.

#### Attendance/Reporting an absence

Regular attendance is required of all students. If students are marked absent for one class or more, the "School Messenger" Computer system will call/email home.

Students who become ill during the school day must report to the medical room in the office. The first aid attendant may need to contact the parent and advise the parent of the student's condition. Please provide correct contact numbers for this purpose in the event of an emergency.

- **By phone (604-713-8950)** Absences taken by phone are adjusted on the computer system usually within the same day unless data entry is delayed for any reason.
- **By note**—Please use the paper note that is available to print from our <u>website</u>. Students may pick up an absence note from the office as well. These notes provide more detailed and accurate data for us to input. Thank you for your cooperation.
- **Signing out**—If a student is ill during school hours, they must come to the office to sign out. Prior to them leaving, the office staff will contact their parent for permission.
- **Field Trips**—The teacher is asked to compile a list of attendees for field trips based on forms returned to them. These lists are then forwarded to the office for data entry. If no list was received, you may get a call through our automated system.
- **Automated message**—You will receive an automated message/email if your son/daughter has missed a class at any time of the school day. To correct any errors, you must contact the teacher who marked them absent.
