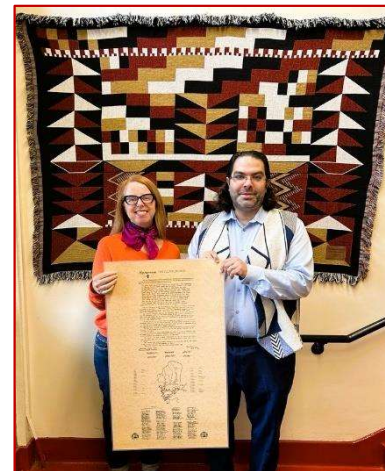

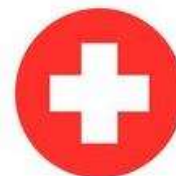
SAFETY WEEK
