INTRODUCTION

This report provides the financial results of the operating fund for the nine months ended March 31, 2023, compared to the budget for the same period.

This report is provided for information.

BACKGROUND

The School District's financial activities are accounted for using Public Sector Accounting Board ("PSAB") reporting standards. The financial activities incurred by the District are recorded in three different funds: the operating fund, the capital fund and numerous special purpose funds. Together they form a consolidated Statement of Revenue and Expense for the District. This year-to-date financial report is for the operating fund only. The operating fund contains the grants supplied by the Ministry of Education and Child Care and other sources of revenue and includes expenses related to the provision of educational services.

ANALYSIS

The following table presents the results for the third quarter (January to March) of the year as well as year-to-date results compared to the amended budget for those time periods. The Committee was informed about this new reporting format at the November 23rd meeting as it provides a better comparator to the actual results than using the annual budget. Previous reports to the Finance Committee compared the year-to-date results to the annual budget and the prior year year-to-date amounts. That



analysis resulted in a detailed report that explained the variance amounts, from a numerical perspective but not the more specific reasons behind the variances. In the current report, staff will provide operational updates that better explain the variances for the Committee. The year-to-date budget is a new concept for the District and was determined using known information about the budget categories and historical trend analysis and will continue to be refined throughout the year (see Appendix A).

Previous quarterly reports compared actual results against the Annual Budget that was approved in May 2022. This third quarter report compares actual results against the Amended Annual Budget, approved in February 2023, which includes the impact of the September enrolment count, the use of prior year surplus, as well as other updates that have occurred year-to-date. Because the budget updates apply to the entire fiscal year-to-date, the third quarter variances include the effect of budget amendments that were made in the first two quarters of the year, as well as the third quarter. Therefore, this report focuses on year-to-date variances and does not discuss third quarter variances.

At the end of March, the District is in a deficit position from regular operations of \$8.16 million, a \$2.46 million favourable variance from the year-to-date budget of \$10.62 million. This is an improvement from the \$10.92 million deficit reported at the end of the previous quarter as the third quarter resulted in a surplus of \$2.45 million which was presented to the Committee during the 2023-2024 budget discussion at the April 12, 2023, meeting.

REVENUE

The year-to-date revenue is higher than budgeted, with a favorable variance of \$5.84 million, mostly due to operating grants from the Ministry of Education and Child Care, tuitions, other revenue, and investment income. The District received \$4.18 million in operating grants to fund support staff salary increases that had not been announced prior to the approval of the 2022-23 Amended Annual Budget. The \$1.35 million variance in tuition revenue is due to an enrolment increase in the February intake of international students. Although the students were registered when the Amended Annual Budget was approved, the district did not have confirmation of their attendance and so the increased enrolment was not reflected in the amended budget. The District also received \$0.29 million more in donations and grants, but experienced \$0.15 million lower than targeted rental income as community rentals continue to lag behind pre-pandemic levels.



Interest Income being ahead of budget of \$0.18 million is reflective of higher cash balances in district accounts than projected during the budget development process. The budget assumption has accounted for the Bank of Canada interest rate increases that have taken place this year.

EXPENSES

Salaries and Benefits

The budget assumption applied in the above table with respect to salaries refers to a combination of actual number of workdays in the quarter and an historical trend analysis for summer work. When looking at the various categories of salaries it is important to recognize that the different employee groups work various times, resulting in a different number of workdays throughout the year. Educational Assistants and Teachers are primarily 10-month employees (September to June) so will have fewer workdays than Principals and Vice-Principals and Other Professionals who are primarily 12-month employees (July to June). The Support Staff employee group has a mix of 10 and 12-month employees.

The year-to-date unfavourable salaries expense variance of \$3.05 million was experienced in all salary categories except for Substitutes, which had a favourable variance.

The unfavourable variances in Educational Assistants of \$1.18 million and Support Staff salaries of \$2.07 million are primarily due to the general wage increases negotiated in support staff collective agreements and the resulting retroactive payment dating back to July 1, 2022, being paid in March 2023. The Ministry had not yet confirmed the funding for the support staff labour settlement when the 2022-23 Amended Annual Budget was approved, and therefore the increased expense was not included.

There continues to be a shortage of custodial staff due to recruitment challenges. Essential work is often being completed by staff working overtime.

While there continues to be a significant cost in substitute salaries due to increased absences related to a higher use of sick leave, there is a slight improvement in the third quarter which resulted in a \$0.23 million favourable variance compared to the Amended Annual Budget estimate. There continues to be an expectation that this expense will exceed the budget for the year.

The unfavourable variance of \$0.90 million in benefits expense is mostly due to wage related benefits associated with support staff salary increases that were not included in the Amended Annual Budget mentioned above.

Services and Supplies

The favourable year-to-date variance in the Services and Supplies category of \$0.15 million is mostly due to lower expenses for supplies and utilities, offset by unfavourable variances in dues and fees and insurance.

The favourable spending for Supplies is reflective of actual spending being lower than the historical trend analysis for this expense category. Also, the Food Nutrition Program has been able to achieve savings by operating two commissary kitchens, thereby reducing the use of catering companies to supplement





production and delivery. These savings are offset by increases in other supplies spending such as custodial supplies and fuel.

The favourable variance of \$0.11 million in utilities expense is due to a cost-of-living credit of \$0.14 million from BC Hydro received this quarter.

The District uses operating funds to purchase capital assets and enter into capital leases. The favourable variance for the first nine months of the year is due to lower school spending compared to previous years, as the budget is based on the historical trend of purchases.

BACKGROUND

Under Section 82 of the School Act, "a board must publish a schedule of the fees to be charged and deposits required and must make the schedule available to students and to children under section 13 and to the parents of those students and children before the beginning of the school year".

All elementary and secondary school fee schedules align with the standardized school fee schedules and comply with legislation and AP 505. There are no registration fees associated with enrolling in district choice programs in elementary schools, including Fine Arts, International Baccalaureate (Middle/Primary Years programs), Intensive French, Mandarin Bilingual, and Multi Age Cluster Class (MACC).

All fee schedules contain the Vancouver School District's Financial Hardship clause.

TREK PROGRAM

TREK is a district integrated outdoor education program for Grade 10 students. The program must annually generate funds through a \$1300 TREK Student Fee (bursaries are available upon request) and fundraising projects, to pay for equipment and field trip expenses. There is a \$200 nonrefundable deposit required upon acceptance into the program. The remainder of the fees are paid at the start of the school year.

PW MINI

Mini school enrichment fee: \$180 covers costs for in-house workshops, guest speakers, field trips (Bard on the Beach, Pacific Cinemethique, Arts Club Theatres, Vancouver Opera), Math exams, Science shows, workbooks, and school service projects. 

ITEM 2.2 Update on Food Framework Vision & Feeding Futures Food Program Shehzad Somji, Assistant Secretary Treasurer

Feeding Futures School Food Program

- \$214.5 million over three years, \$71.5 million committed for 2023-24 (Provincial)
- VSB allocation \$5,566,910
- Dedicated, multi-year funding to increase food security for students by expanding or creating school food programs
- 2023-24 is the foundational year and funding is flexible to provide time to develop a longer-term approach to deliver school food programs
- Criteria will be adjusted over time and standardized spending criteria will be in place for 2025-26

Feeding Futures School Food Program

- Food
 - Maintain current programs, increase number of students served, increase nutrition
 - Support Culinary Arts programs if food produced is provided to students in need
 - Program delivery should be stigma free, flexible, and respect student privacy
- Staff
 - Flexibility to hire up to one School Food Coordinator FTE if needed or offset existing costs
- Other (Foundational Year only)
 - Small appliances or equipment to prepare, store, cook, and transport food
 - Continuity of SFAF supports that improve student food security (e.g. grocery store gift cards, food for weekends and school closures)

Feeding Futures School Food Program – Next Steps

- \$1.8 million approved in 2023-24 budget to fund food programs currently in existence that were not previously funded by the Ministry
- Workshops will be scheduled with District stakeholders, Vancouver District Students' Council, Vancouver District Parent Advisory Council, and the three Host Nations to get input on a spending plan for the remaining \$3.6 million.
