- 5. Reports:

### a. Vice Principal - Elyssa

- As mentioned at the last meeting, the school is making use of a learning video series presented by the VSO. Staff showed a video during a school-wide virtual assembly, but the video was lagging because it would not preload. The teachers are figuring out how to resolve this.
- February is Black History Month. Teachers have been using this as a focus for professional development and are building capacity at the school to incorporate these themes more deeply throughout the year.
- The ministry has announced changes to masking requirements at schools. Masks must be worn by all adults while in common areas and in learning groups, except while sitting or standing at workstations or while eating.
- The district has supplied 3-ply masks to students and teachers
- The COVID-19 test kit pilot project was successful, so VCH is expanding it to other facilities beyond Providence Health
- The teachers are exploring indigenous storytelling resources available through ArtStarts.
- Feb 26 is Pink Shirt day

### b. DPAC - Michael

- The Vancouver District PAC (DPAC) is looking for feedback regarding the school liaison officer (SLO) program
  - DPAC is considering a proposal to cancel or suspend the SLO program and replace it with another
  - General feedback is that the SLO program is working well for younger students, but is not as effective in the high schools
  - Elyssa shared some positive experiences she has had with the SLO program

- Reminder to the school that the PAC passed a budget for a Boardmaker license. The staff was taking advantage of a free trial. Elyssa will find out when the trial ends and whether or not the staff would like to purchase the license


