## Principal's Report by Risha Golby:

Friends For Life: Division 4 and 5 are participating in the Friends Program. The Program is being facilitated by our Area Counsellor, Indira Dhari. This program helps students find positive ways to deal with anxiety, and/or helps a student support a friend who is feeling anxious.

Laurie Eagles SOAR: All 12 Divisions are working towards developing a school wide social responsibility mantra. The students have voted and chosen to adopt an Eagle as the new Laurier Mascot. We will use the acronym Laurie Eagles SOAR to frame our social responsibility language. Currently each division is submitting suggestions for what each letter will stand for. The staff will vote on the student generated ideas and develop a school wide social responsibility curriculum under each of the headings. (for example S- safety O- open Mind etc.)

Adam's Apples: Laurier has partnered with an organization called Adam's Apples - which promotes "Taking Two." The concept is that if you have something on your mind, or just want to chat with a friend that you both grab two apples and fit a quiet place to have a chat and take two minutes to say what is on your mind. The apples are donated to our school every two weeks.

The Transformative Curriculum Update: Two Laurier teachers and myself attended a training session delivered by the Ministry around the topic of the new curriculum. These teachers will act as facilitator and help plan our two curriculum implementation days coming up in March and April of this year.
