Peer Tutoring 12 Placement Form

Peer Tutoring offers senior students an opportunity to develop strong communication, interpersonal and leadership skills through assisting other students in classroom settings. These skills are crucial in post-secondary and workplace applications. Peer tutors function as individual tutors, class teaching assistants, activity leaders, discussion facilitators, role models and mentors. Students will be placed in a class based on school needs, and considering student requests for subject area when possible. Some students may have two placements over the course of the semester to provide a greater breadth of experience for peer tutors and to provide more classes with supports. If enrolment permits, some grade 8 classes will have two Peer Tutors so that tutors can most effectively collaborate with each other and with the teacher to provide student supports.

Peer tutor placements will be done in consultation with peer tutors. Some training will be provided. Peer tutors will work under the supervision of a teacher, and students will be required to complete one or two readings and maintain a reflection log.

Students taking Peer Tutoring 12 will be assigned a class and teacher to work with. Priority for placements will be Grade 8 classes (especially academics), English Language Learner (ELL) and math classes.
