FLASHCARDS FOR PRESENTATIONS

Why use flashcards for presentations?

not reading word for word

presentation sounds more natural easy to make eye contact with audience

important points stand out

can add cues and props

can add timing and transitions

TIPS FOR WRITING FLASHCARDS

- Use only one card for each topic
- Write on one side only
- Write neatly so it's easy to read
- Leave white space so important points stand out
- Write the topic on the top left corner
- Use colour to identify different important info
- Use bullet points instead of sentences
- Include prop cues (e.g. Show slide 1 of PowerPoint)
- Include transitions to show when to move to the next topic
- Include the approximate timing on the cards

TIPS FOR ORGANIZING

- Number each card on the bottom right corner
- Put a hole on the top left corner of the front of the card
- Keep the cards together with a ring or string
