Below is the dress requirements for each division according to the song they are performing! That being said, it is not necessary to buy a whole new outfit for the performance. Anything that your child has that is similar or close is great! Please send your child with their concert dress on both Feb 22nd and 23rd.

1920's- Div 20/21: Brown or white top, black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress)

1930/40's- Div 5/6: Sunglasses and Sun-hats, Yellow top with dark bottoms (skirt, pants, dress) or 30's clothing- Skirts and cardigans, pigtails & trousers and button up shirts.

1950's- Div 19: Black or red top, black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress)

1960's- Div 18: Yellow top, black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress) or 'Peace & Love' 60's attire (sunglasses, tye dye shirts, headbands, flowy shirts and dresses, vests, bell bottom pants)

1970's- Div 3/4: Black top and black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress) or 70's rock n' roll attire (jean jacket, sunglasses, bandana)

1980's-Div 1/2: Bright top, dark bottoms or 80's attire (bright neon clothing, jean & jean jackets)

1990's- Div 7: yellow top, black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress)

2000's-Div 17: Black top, black bottoms (skirt, pants, dress)

2000's-Div 15/16: Dark top, dark bottom (skirt, pants, dress) or 2000's clothing (baggy jeans, t shirts, hoodies & baseball caps)

### **Conferences**
