Financial Hardship Policy

The Board of Education is committed to ensuring that no school-age student will be denied an opportunity to participate in a course, class or program because of an inability to pay fees. Parents and guardians unable to pay some or all school fees are invited to speak to their child's teacher, school counsellor, and/or the school Principal.

\$35.00 GENERAL SCHOOL FEE

The Vancouver School Board offers the service of purchasing basic school supplies in bulk at wholesale prices and passing the cost savings on to families. The School Supply Fee for 2023-2024 is \$35.00 per student*. This fee covers basic consumable school supplies used for students' personal use such as paper, writing tools, glue sticks, erasers, exercise books and art supplies. Supplies are provided for the full year.

SUPPLEMENTAL FEES

Student Agenda/Planner \$6.00	Some students at Queen Elizabeth Elementary will be using an Agenda/Planner. School agendas/planners are a valuable tool for teaching children how to organize and plan for school. While students are not required to have an agenda/planner it is designed to assist students with the skills of organization and time management and is a very useful communication tool often used between teachers and families.
Performance Fee \$50.00	We are pleased to enrich your child's learning through a wide variety of performances this year. This supplementary fee supports the school in bringing in talented and professional theatrical and musical performers that align with a particular educational theme. Parent support has made these opportunities possible and we appreciate your continued contribution. Sometimes, the PAC covers the whole cost so we may not request this fee.
Workbooks/Online Supplement Resources \$ 50.00	Students in some division will be using a mathematics/language arts practice and homework book. Other classes may be using online supplementary resources. This materials supplements classroom programs. The workbook is available for purchase at the cost of \$50.00. Students are not obligated to purchase the workbook, and may opt to use their copy as a reference textbook instead, meaning the workbook will be returned at the end of the school year for another student to use in the future. Students opting to use the workbook as a textbook will be responsible for ensuring that it remains unmarked and in excellent condition in order to return the workbook at the end of the year and receive reimbursement.
Activity Fee \$50.00	This year some classes will be booking workshops. Parent support for this activity confirmed last school year and we appreciate your contribution towards this opportunity. These fees will be charged at the time the workshops occur. This fee may include gardening, nutrition, workshops/activities. This list is not all inclusive and the cost associated with each vary. \$50.00 estimated.
Other \$15.00	Throughout the year, students may be participating in supplemental activities to support various aspects of the curriculum not covered in other fees. These fees will be charged at a time when the workshops/activities occur. This fee may include healthy living, Indigenous Education, ecological literacy, ADST, nature walk workshops/activities/programs/ supplies. This list is not all inclusive and the cost associated with each vary. Estimated \$15.00.
Grade 7 Farewell \$50.00	This supplementary fee supports the grade 7 Farewell and related activities to help foster team building, leadership and friendship skills.
Field Studies – To be determined throughout the school year at the classroom level	Throughout the school year your child's teacher may plan supplementary learning opportunities at locations outside of the school and request monies towards entrance fees, transportation or equipment rental. Your child's teacher will communicate this information to you directly.
