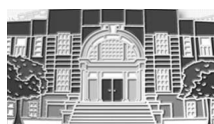

Families Dropping Off/Picking Up Students – How you can help!

Traditionally at Tennyson many of our families wait with younger students before and after school, and enjoy time talking with one another on the school grounds. With the current Public Health Orders in place, it is really important that students go to their Division line-up upon arrival, and that adults refrain from congregating on the grounds. Please drop your child off and know that they are in good hands on the school grounds – we have staff supervision right before and after school. While we noticed that our families made good efforts to distance from one another and from other children, with all students back starting on Monday there just will not be enough room. Also, TOSS/YMCA protocols prevent them from using outdoor spaces if too many families are congregating after school. We love seeing our Tennyson families, but our tight space during construction and with health orders in effect mean that we do need to create a bit more space. Thank you for helping us to achieve this!

Forms, Fees, and Parent/Guardian Contact Info

We have been preparing an envelope for each student containing important forms for you to sign and to return to school. It is important that the Student Verification Information sheet is reviewed and updated. These envelopes will go out to families next week, with a requested return by the following week. Thanks!



We will continue to use SchoolCashOnline to accept payments for all fees to the school. Please see the brochure later in this newsletter for how to use SchoolCashOnline, how to sign up if you do not have an account, and a FAQ.

Safe Arrival – Student Attendance

We will continue to use the district Safe Arrival line to report student absences. This is effective immediately. Instead of calling the main school number, please call (604) 713-5159, and press



84 to select Tennyson. You will then leave a message for the office. **It is vital that all absences are called into the school prior to 9am.** In the past we have had parent volunteers to assist with the call out for students whose families have not reported their absence on the line, however this is postponed. For when we can resume having a volunteer, should you wish to opt out of having your contact information shared confidentially with the Safe Arrival volunteer solely for the purpose of checking to ensure the student is accounted for, please contact the office.

Students Arriving Late to School or Leaving Early

It is very important that students are accounted for, and that we do not have too many students waiting in the foyer. If your child arrives to school late, but it is BEFORE 9:20am, they should go directly to class and the teacher will update the attendance. If they arrive AFTER 9:20am, they should come to the office.

It is also important that students leaving the school prior to 3pm on a given day are signed out. Since the school building is currently restricted to students and staff, please let the classroom teacher know. When you are about to arrive or have just arrived at the school, please call the office and a staff member will release your child to you. We need to physically see that they go with their parent/guardian.

Looking for Volunteers for Divisions 1 to 9 Lunchtime Walks to Connaught Park

All intermediate student learning groups will be scheduled to go to Connaught Park for one lunchtime per week, with parent consent. This gives the students the opportunity to enjoy a designated area in the park, within their learning group. Students would be accompanied by a supervision aide and one or several parent volunteers. If you would like to volunteer to accompany the students to and from the park between about noon and 1pm, please email the school at tennyson@vsb.bc.ca. We are still working on the specific days that learning groups would go to the park, so please let us know when you are available and we'll see it can match up. Volunteers would be required to physically distance from students and are required to read and sign a VSB Volunteer Conduct Agreement that outlines some VSB policies. Thank you for considering helping us to make this great opportunity for our intermediate students a reality!

Due to the current Provincial Health Orders, we are unable to have our traditional in-school barbecue and Meet the Teacher Night. The PAC Exec and school staff will be collaborating on a virtual or alternate format, and this may vary from class to class. More information to come!

Allergy Awareness – Peanuts and Tree Nuts

Please note that we are an *allergy aware* school. We have a number of students with severe allergies to peanuts, tree nuts, and nut products (peanut butter, Nutella, etc). **We ask that everyone avoid bringing lunches and snacks with these ingredients as such ingredients can be dangerous to others.** We have noticed that students sometimes bring Nutella sandwiches to school. Please note that this spread contains nuts and can be potentially dangerous to others. Please try to avoid such spreads. We also ask students to wash hands before and after eating. We appreciate our families working together in this regard.



Medical Conditions

1. Please ensure that the school is informed of any medical condition that may require emergency care at school, ie: anaphylaxis, diabetes, seizures, severe asthma and serious heart conditions.
2. A “Medical Administration” form, completed by a physician, is required for any medication being dispensed by a school staff member. Copies of these forms are available in the office.
3. Parents choosing to keep medication such as an epi-pen or inhaler in the First Aid area at school are responsible for checking expiry dates and providing new supplies as needed.

Student Photo Day

Student Photo Days in VSB schools will need to be postponed until after January. We'll let you know when our photo day will be, closer to the date.

Parking Around the School

Please be aware of parking restrictions around the school. We have been hearing of families getting tickets in these zones, as the neighbourhood is patrolled regularly by City parking enforcement. Please be cognizant of the restricted areas and avoid parking in the prohibited zones, as you are highly likely to receive a ticket.



Construction Update

We are anticipating a fall move-in to our new building, and will communicate the date once it is finalized. Much of the interior is complete, and the crews are working on completing the exterior tarmac sections around the building. It is looking great! Did you know that schools across the province are working to implement a redesigned curriculum, in which content areas are addressed around the building of core competencies in students? This curriculum embeds First People's principles of learning into all subject areas, as well. Here is a description of core competencies (from the Ministry of Education website):

The core competencies along with literacy and numeracy foundations and essential content and concepts are at the centre of the redesign of curriculum and assessment. Core competencies are sets of intellectual, personal, and social and emotional proficiencies that all students need to develop in order to engage in deep learning and life-long learning.

Thinking: The thinking competency encompasses the knowledge, skills and processes we associate with intellectual development. It is through their competency as thinkers that students take subject-specific concepts and content and transform them into a new understanding. Thinking competence includes specific thinking skills as well as habits of mind, and metacognitive awareness.

Communication: The communication competency encompasses the set of abilities that students use to impart and exchange information, experiences and ideas, to explore the world around them, and to understand and effectively engage in the use of digital media.

Personal and Social: Personal and social competency is the set of abilities that relate to students' identity in the world, both as individuals and as members of their community and society. Personal and social competency encompasses the abilities students need to thrive as individuals, to understand and care about themselves and others, and to find and achieve their purposes in the world

- Select **Continue**.
- On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the **Agree** box and select **Continue**.
- Your child has been added to your account.
