Why orange shirts? Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St Joseph Mission residential school commemoration event in Williams Lake, BC, in May, 2013. It grew out of Phyllis Webstad's story of having her new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission. It now helps to keep the discussion of all aspects of residential schools occurring annually. At Byng, we'll wear orange on Monday, Sept 29th in honour of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on Sept 30th. There will also be an assembly on the 29th around Two-Eyed Seeing, a concept shared broadly by Dr. and Elder Albert Marshall.
