

Ms. Koke is back in the library Monday-Wednesday this year, and job-sharing grade 1/2 with Mrs. Chang this year. Ms. Koke will be recruiting library monitors to volunteer this year before and after school Mondays-Wednesdays. Monitor training will begin over the next 2 weeks.

Book Bag information: For primary students who are **new to the school**, **you will be invoiced \$16 on** SchoolCash Online for Book Bag rental. Book bags that were returned to Ms. Koke prior to the summer will be returned to Grade 1-3 students.

The book bags are very important for use in the library, especially by the lower primaries as they protect our books from damage that occurs from being left out on the playground in the rain or coming into contact with water bottles inside a backpack. Thank you for sending your book bags with your child on library day!

Student Use of Cell Phones, Apple Watches & other Electronic Devices at School

We understand that many students carry phones, smartwatches, and other devices for communication before and after school. However, to maintain a safe and focused learning environment, we ask families to support the following guidelines:

PHONE

- During School Hours (8:55 a.m. 3:03 p.m.):
- No device use in classrooms, hallways, or on the playground.
- **Devices must be turned off** and stored in a zipped backpack or a staff-approved location.

If a student is caught using a phone, it will be confiscated and a parent/guardian will be contacted.

Photos & Privacy:

Students may not take photos at school.

Photography is only allowed for school purposes with staff permission and parental consent, in accordance with privacy laws.

Responsibility for Devices:

• The school is **not responsible** for lost, stolen, or damaged personal electronic devices.

CASH ONLINE

The Vancouver School Board now has School Cash Online at **McKechnie Elementary** as its preferred method of payment for all school fees, including field trips and yearbooks. This secure system helps parents/guardians and community members pay school-related fees safely, quickly, and easily online.



The system puts all the school fees available to your student online for purchase, keeping you informed of your child's activities and needs. We will post items through the system and assign the relevant fees to your child. You can then choose to purchase these fees online with one of three different methods, including credit cards. You can also stay informed and keep track of which school fees require your attention. The system strictly adheres to Canada's privacy and anti-spam legislation and meets the latest industry standards for payment security.

If you have not already done so, please take time to register now – a simple process that takes only a few minutes – by visiting https://vsb.schoolcashonline.com and following directions to the School Cash Online page. You will need your child's usual first name, last name, and birth date to register.

To receive email notifications of upcoming fees, please select "YES" and check the box indicating "I want to receive email notifications for new fees assigned to my student and updates on school-related activities." IMPORTANT REMINDERS TO PARENTS:

No Uber Eats or Personal Food Deliveries to Classrooms

We kindly remind parents that 'Uber Eats' and other personal food deliveries are **not permitted to classrooms**. If a student forgets their lunch, parents can drop it off at a table outside the office. It is the student's responsibility to pick up their lunch from there. **Please do not make this a daily/regular routine to bring food during school hours.**

Minimizing Classroom Disruptions

Unless it's an **emergency**, students and teachers should not be disturbed during class time to call home for non-urgent messages, such as who is picking them up or to arrange playdates. These interruptions are very disruptive to the learning environment, and will not be permitted. The office staff is extremely busy and is not able to pass messages on to your children.


