

# Youth WORK in Trades SCHOLARSHIP

## IT STARTS WITH GRADUATION.

This \$1000 scholarship is an initiative of the BC Ministry of Education & Child Care and honours the achievement of students pursuing an apprenticeship. Funds can be applied to the cost of future training only.

**You must graduate to qualify.**

## APPRENTICESHIP COURSEWORK AND HOURS

Students must complete four apprenticeship courses offered through Career Programs. Contact Career Programs to register.

You'll need 900 hours reported on your SkilledTradesBC apprenticeship transcript.

## YOUR GRADES MATTER!

To qualify for the scholarship, you need to have an average of 67% (or higher) in your grade 12 courses.

We suggest setting a personal goal to earn at least 72% in all grade 12 courses to give focus to your learning plans as they move from school to work.

## WHAT'S THE DEADLINE?

The requirements described above must be completed before December 31st of the school year when you turn 19.

This deadline can change, but we strongly encourage you to keep in contact with Career Programs and your employer about reporting your apprenticeship hours.



Applications are open from September 1st to November 15th through the Ministry website.
