This \$1000 award is an initiative of the BC Ministry of Education and honours the achievement of students pursuing an apprenticeship.

The first requirement is that you must graduate to qualify.

900 HOURS OF APPRENTICESHIP

It is your responsibility to work with your employer to ensure that your apprenticeship hours are reported to SkilledTradesBC.

Contact Career Programs teacher when you have reached **480 hours** and again when you have **900 hours** on your transcript.







To earn the award, you need to have an average of 72% (or higher) in all grade 12 courses.

We suggest setting a personal goal to earn at least 72% in all grade 12 courses to give focus to your learning plans as they move from school to work.

WHAT'S THE DEADLINE?

The requirements described above must be completed before December 31st of the school year when you turn 19.

This is a firm deadline, so we strongly encourage you to keep in contact with Career Programs and your employer about reporting your apprenticeship hours.



An application may be required starting in 2024.
