

Snow Closure Information

Please read and distribute copies as needed

The Vancouver School Board has procedures for times when heavy snowfall might affect schools.

- All schools in the Vancouver School Board will remain **open** if possible, during snow events.
- Any school closures will be decided by 7:00 a.m. at the latest.
- Details about school closures will be announced through the media and on our Vancouver School Board website: www.vsb.bc.ca



No announcement will be made stating that schools are open.

Only closures and delayed openings will be announced.

If Adult Education is open, but you cannot travel safely to school, please email your instructor(s) to let them know. What happens when snow events occur during evenings and Saturdays, outside of normal K to 12 hours?

If Adult Ed is open – no email will be sent out and no notice will be placed on the **Adult Education website**.
