#### Team Spirit Day December 14th



# Safety Awareness Corner

Awareness without action is worthless.

Did you know, 5% or 1 in 20 Secord students has a serious food allergy? That's over 30 students!

At Secord, we have students who are allergic to:

- Peanuts
- Tree nuts (pistachios, cashews, almonds, hazelnuts, walnuts, etc.) and products made using tree nuts (nut butters, Nutella, etc.)
- Sesame seeds and products made using sesame (tahini, hummus, sesame snacks, sushi rolls topped with sesame seeds, etc.)
- fish and shellfish
- kiwi
- eggs
- dairy
- soy

Please take this into account when preparing your child's snacks and lunches or when sending food to school.

Welcome to December. The Peer Helpers are once again spearheading the HAND TO HAND Project in support of the Downtown East Side. For those of you new to Secord this is a project that began a few years ago (2014)...Past students came up with the name of this project & its focus.

**HOW IT WORKS (THE BIG PICTURE):** for 2 weeks in December the classes/students of Secord collect personal care items for folks who live in the Downtown East Side. We currently donate these many items to the Union Gospel Mission where they are distributed to residents of the mission as well as those involved in their outreach street program. Due to covid we are distributing boxes to each classroom for the items to be collected, students will not be in contact with the items.

**HOW IT WORKS AT SCHOOL:** We will be making morning announcements to encourage school wide participation, as well a member of the Peer Helpers will visit your class sometime this week to talk about the items we are requesting from your class. The items are divided into Grade Groups:

Our last official collection day will be Wednesday December 15th (however the items will be delivered on Dec 16/17.)
