

SAFE PLANET Vancouver Art Contest, 2011-2012 Student Heroes for the Environment

Contest begins 9 December, runs until May 18, 2012 Final selections announced June 15, 2012

Safe Planet: the United Nations Campaign for Responsibility on Hazardous Chemicals and Wastes is pleased to announce the launch of the Vancouver Art Contest. Our goal is to raise awareness in Youth about Climate Change, toxic pollution and the growing chemical Body Burden now nearly endemic to our society. We are actively engaging Youth in working towards creative solutions for eliminating the many hazards present in our daily environment.

To that end, we are looking for Safe Planet Heroes, young artists, and imaginative students across Vancouver, to create a work of art that demonstrates the possibilities of life in a world without hazardous chemicals and waste. Examples of the problems we are faced with are: single-use plastics currently damaging our oceans, the toxic emissions polluting the air we breathe, and appearance of unwanted chemicals pesticides in the food we eat. What are your solutions? The bottom line is a call for a strong image that represents a Safe Planet, free of hazardous chemicals and wastes. All two-dimensional media are welcomed: photographs, paintings, drawings, graphics.

Besides prizes, five winners will have their winning designs reproduced on an eco

conscious, reusable Shopping Tote that will be used for fundraising in the Vancouver district, as well as future Safe Planet events internationally. The new **Safe Planet Heroes** will be announced at a joint Press Conference with the Vancouver School Board in mid-June, 2012.

Rules

Each school is asked to submit two finalists by May 18, 2012. Team submissions (of up to 2 students) are welcomed. (If an 8-12 grade team is selected for the ArtMill prize, the cost will be split between the two). Scanned images of the work, plus a one paragraph text can be sent in 2 separate pdf. files to:

Final entries must include:

- 1. name of the student
- 2. name of the school and teacher
- 3. student's age, home address, phone number, parental contact (email + phone)
- 4. descriptive paragraph of the project + image

By entering the Competition, winning students have assigned copyright of their paintings/artwork to the organizers. Original artwork will not be returned and will be used to raise environmental awareness through the UN Safe Planet websites, posters, publications etc., and to raise funds to further promote environmental activities by youth.
