This six week program if fulltime at the Piping Industry College of BC from mid-June to late July.

# Steps to become certified in this trade as a RED SEAL PLUMBER

- 6 weeks school (ACE IT)
  Level 1 Technical Training
  - 6 weeks Levels 2 & 3
    - 8 weeks Level 4
  - 6420 total work based training hours

### WHAT DO YOU ACCOMPLISH?

When you have successfully completed this program with a **70%** pass rate you will have earned:

- Level 1 Technical Training of the Plumbing Program which will save you \$1800 in tuition
- 8 credits towards high school graduation
- additional 16 credits if enrolled in Secondary School Apprenticeship either during or at the completion of the ACE IT program

Having achieved this you will be able to start your apprenticeship with a trades qualified Plumber.
