PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original 1914 wood frame building has been upgraded for school use and connected to a new partial replacement school. The new portion of the school will be constructed at the southwest corner of the school property.

The new building is a two storey structure and classroom spaces are designed as integrated Learning Communities.

Early Learning, Kindergarten and grades 1 - 2 are located on the ground floor. Intermediate and senior grades are located on the second floor.

The school design includes an enlarged multi-purpose room suitable for music programs and out-of-school care, an integrated performance space within the gym and a variety of informal social and flex learning space throughout the school.
