PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The former University Hill Secondary School was converted into a new elementary school to accommodate students from Kindergarten to Grade 8.

The design concept envisions two school Learning Communities within the school facility, Kindergarten through Grade 5 will be housed in one wing, while a second wing will house Grades 6-8. The core of the school will house the administration, library, gym, multi-purpose space and Student Commons area.

Key design features include adaptable learning spaces for large and small groupings, flexible group assembly space, central Student Commons area, and clustered Learning Communities.
