PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The school structure was built in 1967 and designed in the Early Modern architectural style. The school is a typical example of educational facilities built in the 1960s era.

The single storey design incorporate classrooms along a central corridor. Classrooms have exterior doors to directly access the school grounds.

The school building and covered play area were seismically upgraded in 2009. The exterior and interior layout was retained and not significantly impacted by the seismic upgrade.
