PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The seismic work included upgrading the classrooms and portions of the existing exterior walls and adding new shearwalls. The three-storey wing consisting of the gym and multi-purpose room has been replaced. The new gymnasium/multi-purpose wing is designed to post-disaster standard. Existing feature windows were reclaimed and incorporated into the school.

The main school building is designed in a Classical Revival architectural style. The addition is designed in a Contemporary architectural style.

The project also improves the building's accessibility and functionality. Enhancements include upgrading the administrative and staff room areas, the provision of additional learning assistance and resource spaces as well as the installation of an elevator.
