PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The main brick building was built in two stages, in 1912 and 1925. Various additions and renovations were completed over the years to accommodate the neighbourhood's population growth.

The main building is a three storey structure designed in a Classical Revival architectural style. The school's additions and renovations were designed in Early Modern and Contemporary styles.

The school was seismically upgraded in 2003. Heritage elements that were retained include the brick facade, exterior building details and window design. An elevator was installed and accessibility improvements were made where possible.
