PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original school was established in 1908. The main brick building was constructed in 1922 with an addition constructed in 1957.

The main building is a three storey brick structure. The main Brick building is designed in a Classical Revival architectural style and has a Heritage "A" designation. The addition is designed in an Early Modern architectural style.

The main building was seismically upgraded in 2006. Heritage elements that were retained include the brick facade, exterior building details and window design. In addition, accessibility improvements were made where possible.
